THE BASICS

We like to think sharing what we grow with you is the best way to re-connect to the land, the local experience and to our community.

We offer high quality, naturally grown vegetables and herbs with options.
It's local!

Choose from Full Share (1-2 people) or Deluxe Share (3-4 people) and the options within the Grand Grocer, Budding Chef or Giddy Gourmet tiers of membership.

Our members receive their farm shares weekly, delivered to local drop off points within the city or can have home delivery for an additional charge in approved areas.

We also offer ala carte items when available through the Store.
These can be added to weekly deliveries.



THE DETAILS

YOUR PLEDGE: Becoming a member of Compost In My Shoe's CSA Farm Share means that you pledge to support our local farm in its operations by pre-paying a fee in exchange for a share of the harvest. Ours is year round. We stop periodically throughout the year based on growing cycles that don't yield enough to continue that week. Not to worry, we let you know when these times come along.

You also acknowledge and share in the risk that the farm takes to plant, tend and harvest. This is what the Community Supported Agriculture model is all about. We work with Mother Nature as closely as possible. She has a bad day now and then, letting us know who's in control.

SIGNING UP: We use Farmigo to manage the Farm Share Program experience. On Farmigo, you will create a unique account, purchase shares, choose delivery locations, schedule more shares and a whole lot more!



PICKING UP PRODUCE: You agree to arrive at the delivery point within the allotted time on a specific day, transfer the goodies to your own bags, and start dreaming about dinner! Our bins with containers should always be left behind. We sanitize and reuse! Go green. If you or your designated pick-up person does not pick up within the time frame, you agree to donate it to our favorite weekly causes.

LEAVING TOWN: Out of town and need to stop deliveries? Schedule these through your account with your login and password. There is a two week maximum on stop deliveries. Find a friend who loves high quality produce to pick it up after that point or have them pick up the entire time you are on vacation, a nice way to share the bounty with a friend.

PAYING FOR PRODUCE: You can pay by credit card, check or better yet sign on the autopay option. This ensures your account is being payed in a timely fashion so you never miss a delivery. If you choose to renew manually, an email letting you know it's time to renew comes in just enough time to keep it coming!

UPDATES: We won't flood your computer with unnecessary emails, but when we do, it means there is important information about deliveries, produce selections or new and exciting offerings. Please read our emails as soon as you see them.
